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
### MONTESORRI 3 TO 6 YEARS

The joy of learning is more evident and effortless than perhaps at any other stage of life. Through natural curiosity, the child absorbs information, assimilates it with his senses, and constructs his own knowledge.

The Montessori method of education gives children ages 3–6 unique opportunities to learn more thoroughly, quickly, and efficiently through experience, guidance, and practice. The Montessori educator is the dynamic link to the environment, provides peaceful order and a caring approach to learning. All roads point toward independence and an active connection to the world.

## Room 1

This month our students will be working with sounds, numbers from 1 through 20, and pouring exercises. Students will also practice saying "Please" and "Thank you," and learn a continent song. In Science we will be studying parts of the leaf and in Geography, we will learn about Africa. Las partes de la casa, the parts of the house, will be taught in Spanish and our health lesson this month will be on good food choices.



## Rooms 2 & 3

In Sensorial this month our students will focus on ovals and the color blue, in Language we will practice sounding out the letters "S" and "F." In Math, students will work with the numbers "3" and "4." Students will practice their table manners and how to properly carry a mat in the classroom this month. In Science, we will introduce the seasonal changes from summer to fall. In Geography, we will explore the deserts in Africa while learning about different African animals in Spanish.

## Rooms 4 & 5

For Language, students will learn how to sound out the letters "A" and "T" while learning how to count from 0 to 5 in Math. In Geography, we will learn about Africa and about African animals in Spanish.

Also in Spanish, students will learn colors and shapes. This month's shape is a square and this month's color is blue. These skills will also apply to their art classes this month. In Science, we will introduce the changing of seasons from summer to fall and in music they will learn the 7 days of the week song in English and in Spanish.
